here is a more detailed report.

1. CCB Status

CCB Status produced on 1/6/96 had one discrepancy: CP69 was marked as ACCEPTED but its corresponding DR84 was said to be RESOLVED. Strange...

Outstanding DR/CPs

The following DR/CPs were outstanding. Here is their real status (according to me). All this should be cross checked by DR/CP authors.

- DR 070 applies to draft GM table 10-1, which I haven't seen. Probably still outstanding. GM editor should be informed of this!
- DR 105 has been implemented without a CP (now refers to 5.6.2.2.6.2.1.). Proposal to become RESOLVED
- DR 106 no CP but I would consider it covered as a result of CP69 modifications. Proposal to become RESOLVED
- DR 107 same as DR 106
- CP 069 I consider this CP as implemented. I haven't checked all details, but the corresponding section has gone through detailed rewordings and looks good to me. Proposal to become IMPLEMENTED.

Note. — Klaus-Peter is the author of CP069 and DR 105-107. I think it would be a good idea to ask him to review this.

3. Conclusion:

All outstanding CP/DR resolved EXCEPT a DR pertaining to GM. For a clean job, you may fancy the idea of withdrawing it with a WG2 Action to the GM editor to take it into account.
